Between 2000 and 2005, Sivakumar served as the President of the Youth Wing of Siva Sena under the leadership of Bal Thackeray. He worked under the guidance of Tamil Nadu leaders Nagai Mugan, Thenmanavan, and Kalanghiya Devan. His tenure was marked by vibrant youth engagement, political organization, and assertive representation of Sanatana values. His leadership earned respect across state lines.

During this period, he served as the Personal Assistant to Manohar Joshi, the former Chief Minister of Maharashtra. He played a crucial role during a politically sensitive time, particularly when Lok Sabha Speaker G.M.C. Balayogi tragically died in a helicopter crash in 2002.


Sivakumar's association with towering leaders like Bal Thackeray and Manohar Joshi enriched his understanding of political leadership, organization building, and public service.
